Weehawken Snow Removal Operations Update**

Dear Residents,

Our snow response plan is now being actively implemented across the Township. Crews will begin tonight by addressing critical public safety locations, including emergency routes, fire hydrants, school zones, public property, senior housing, main corridors, and key intersections to ensure uninterrupted access for EMS, Fire, and Police.

This storm has produced approximately 20-22 inches of snow, with drifts as high as 4 feet across the Township, requiring a sustained, coordinated response over several days.

Operations will continue tomorrow and throughout the week as we move systematically through town. While you may not see every location fully cleared at once, high-use and safety-sensitive areas must be addressed first to maintain access for the entire community. As those areas are secured, crews will continue expanding into residential streets and secondary locations. Snow removal and hauling will take place as conditions safely allow.

When removal or hauling operations require temporary adjustments to a specific block or in a particular area, residents will be notified in advance whenever possible so we can complete the work safely and efficiently.

If you observe a specific safety concern, such as blocked emergency access, a buried hydrant, or a hazardous intersection, please notify the Township. We understand the challenges snow creates. Once essential areas are clear, we will move into as many neighborhoods as possible. Our focus remains steady: protect access, maintain safety, and continue progress.
