PROVISIONAL BALLOT VOTER:

A voter who has moved within the county, prior to an election, without filing with the county commissioner of registration or applicable municipal clerk, a notice of change of residence; or otherwise notifying the commissioner of registration of a change of address (including not returning

a confirmation notice, if sent to voter) shall be permitted to correct the voter's registration and vote in the general election by provisional ballot at the polling place for the election district in which the voter resides on the day of the election. The voter may contact the county commissioner of registration or municipal clerk to determine their proper polling place.
