

# WEEHAWKEN TOWNSHIP POOL COMPLEX

## Rules and Regulations

- **Membership ID cards are required for admittance.**
- **ID cards are non-transferable and must be kept for future years.**
- **Replacement Fee: \$10 per card for lost, misplaced, or damaged ID cards.**

Pool Rules and Regulations will be strictly enforced. Lifeguards and Staff are responsible for enforcing pool rules. **Discourteous behavior towards the Lifeguards, staff, or other guests of the pool will not be tolerated, and offenders will be asked to leave the pool complex.**

- **The pool complex will be open for New Jersey residents only with current membership.**
- **Children 17 years old and under must be accompanied/chaperoned by an adult who is an immediate family member or resides in the same household. NO DROPPING OFF CHILDREN AND LEAVING.**
- All minor **children must be supervised by an adult (18 and older) at ALL times in ALL areas** of the pool complex, especially children who are non-swimmers.
- All persons using the pools must shower prior to entering the pool.
- Persons experiencing, having symptoms of, or recovering from the following: diarrhea, open sores, cuts, wearing bandages, excessive sunburn, open blisters, inflamed eyes, or cold, nasal, or ear discharges will not be allowed in any of the pools. New Jersey State Law-N.J.A.C. 8:26-5.4
- **NO CHEWING GUM.**
- No spitting, expectorating, spouting of water, or other similar actions will be allowed in the pool areas.
- **No DIAPERS** in pool (except swim diapers).
- **For health and safety reasons, diaper changing, hair combing, and personal grooming are strictly prohibited on all pool decks. Family changing rooms must be used at all times.**
- No street shoes are permitted on the deck.
- No animals/pets are allowed in the pool complex.
- No one will be allowed in the water unless a Lifeguard is present.
- **No diving/jumping into pools, running, pushing, dunking, horseplay, or unauthorized ball playing.**
- In accordance with New Jersey State safety regulations, the pool will be closed immediately during lightning, thunder, or other dangerous conditions. All patrons must exit the pool complex and remain out for **a minimum of 45 minutes following the last thunder or lightning strike. No exceptions.**
- Proper swimwear is **required at all times. Cut-offs, t-shirts, gym shorts, and all other street clothing are strictly prohibited in the swimming pools. Patrons in violation will be required to exit the pool.**
- **Swim attire in and out of the pool area will be consistent with proper decorum-no indecent or unnecessary exposure.** Please remember this is a family pool.
- Masks, fins, snorkels, rafts, water guns, or floats are not permitted.

- No roughness, rowdiness, profanity, or other conduct unpleasant to, or affecting the comfort of others.
- **Bags and coolers may be checked at all the entrances for alcohol and glass bottles.** If these items are found by Staff, the individual will not be permitted access to the complex until items have been properly removed or discarded.
- **Smoking/Vaping, alcoholic beverages, and glass bottles are prohibited on the premises. Any intoxicated person will be denied entry and will be removed from the complex.**
- Food and beverages are not permitted outside designated food areas.
- **Picnic tables are for dining purposes only.** Personal belongings may not be left on tables for extended periods. **Tables may not be reserved or used for storage.**
- Personal umbrellas are not allowed in the complex.
- No bikes, skateboards, roller skates, or scooters.
- **The Township is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal property.**
- **No person shall photograph or videotape an unrelated person(s) without their consent and the consent of a legal guardian for those under 18 years of age.** The use of recording devices (cameras, video cameras, cell phones) is not permitted in restroom areas. Management reserves the right to deny the use of recording devices at their discretion.
- **All members and guests are required to know and follow all rules and regulations. Township staff, the Weehawken Police Department, and authorized agents have full authority to enforce these rules and to immediately stop, restrict, or remove any individual engaging in unsafe, improper, disruptive, or prohibited conduct.**

#### **Ages & Requirements for Pool Use**

- Small Wading Pool: Ages 1–3 only
- **Spray Park: Ages 3–12 only – strictly enforced**
  - Family Pool: All ages welcome
- Lap Pool: Ages 14 and up – experienced swimmers only
- **Water Slide: Minimum height: 48 inches. Maximum weight: 300 lbs. – strictly enforced**

**FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES MAY RESULT IN MEMBERSHIP SUSPENSION.**

**You MAY bring your own food, water and soft drinks (NO alcohol).  
Deliveries of outside food ARE permitted to the Complex.**
